



## Cub Program at Camp Karluk



*Below are only some of the highlights of the Cub Program. The complete detailed program will be included in the welcome package at camp.*

- **Arrival Friday afternoon:** Cubs will be given a challenging game to be completed at their leisure throughout the evening and the next couple of days with clues to be obtained from various places on site.
- **Friday evening:** Cubs are invited to don their Bartlett costumes and proceed to the swimming breach for the opening festivities including special guest Captain Bob Bartlett (Steve O'Connell) and finally fireworks.
- **Saturday and Sunday mornings and afternoons:** Cubs will participate in a series of events, with 2 in the morning and 2 in the afternoon of both days. These events include ❶ an obstacle course though the Torngat Mountains of Labrador with a mud hole at the end, of course; ❷ canoeing; crossing "ice pans" for a bird's-eye view of a seal (not a real live one, of course as it is too warm for them to be around at that time of the year); ❸ a visit to the Trading Post to make a mini dog-sled; ❹ a chance to carve an iceberg out of stone (or carve anything else that comes to mind) at our tent at the North Pole; ❺ learn how to bandage frozen toes, walk with a crutch on a broken leg, or carry a stretcher across frozen land, as may have happened while on a Captain (Bob) Robert Bartlett adventure across the frozen Arctic; ❻ catch fish in the frozen waters of Nor' Wes Pond like the crewmen of Captain Bob Bartlett; and ❼ hunt for treasure in the forest of Eastern Labrador.
- **Saturday and Sunday evenings:** see the Cubs participating in the Bob Bartlett look-alike contest; a campfire on Saturday evening; and on the Main Stage on Sunday evening, **the Nor'Wes Idol competition**. All this along with having a lot of fun with the many Cubs, Scouts and Venturers from Newfoundland and Labrador, other Canadian Provinces and the USA.
